WORKER & GOOD WORKER

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN "GOOD WORKERS" AND PEOPLE WHO "JUST WORK" INTERACT?

Remember, "good work" includes all three elements of the three Es-- excellence, ethics, and engagement, whereas work can sometimes be missing one or more of these elements; we would consider this type of work just "work." Importantly, work that isn't good work isn't necessarily bad work, but it could be bad work.

Here, we want you to explore these ideas by writing up a short (<5 minutes) discussion, interaction, or debate between two workers in the same job or industry. Worker #1 should be someone who represents a "good worker" in this job, while worker #2 is someone who is just doing "work"-- meaning they are missing one or more of the 3Es.

What kind of discussion might these two workers have about their work together? This is your chance to use your imagination and to tell us more about what you think it means to do good work.
